

MyOwn Telco: Zoiper Installation Guide

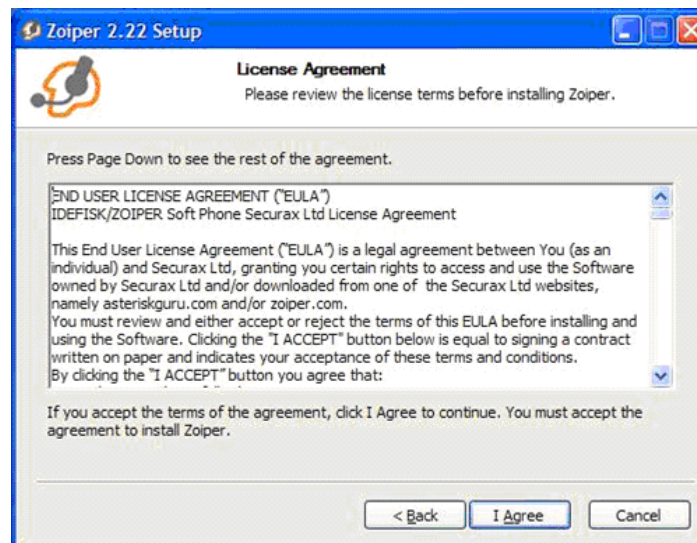
Here follows the different steps to have the free Zoiper Classic softphone installed and configured to access the [MyOwn Telco](http://myowntelco.net) network or any other Asterisk PBX based system. By following this procedure you will be able to make and receive calls using the phone number you have chosen (see list of available cities here: <http://myowntelco.net/canada-voip-did-numbers.php>) for your JaFone account.

1) Download Zoiper Classic by visiting the Zoiper web site: <http://www.zoiper.com/zwin.php>

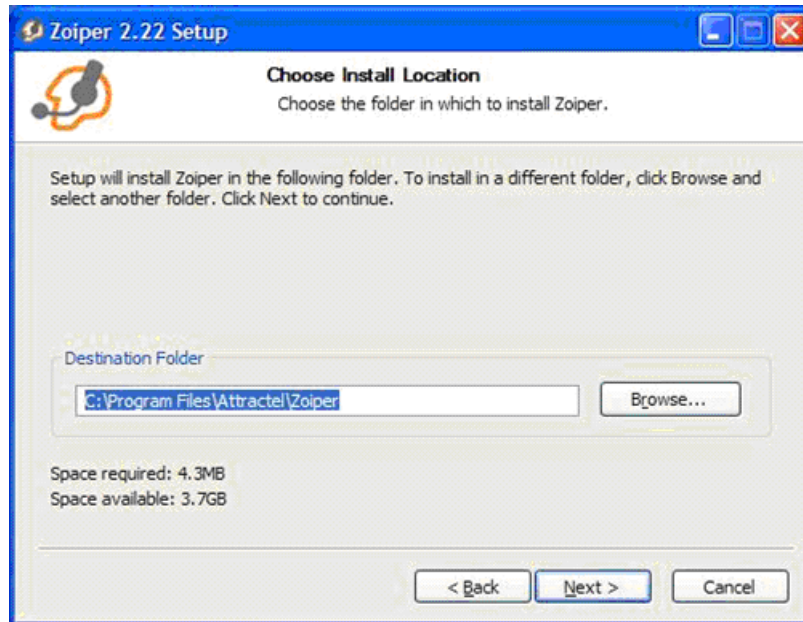
2) Start the installation process by opening the downloaded archive and click **Next** on the first screen:



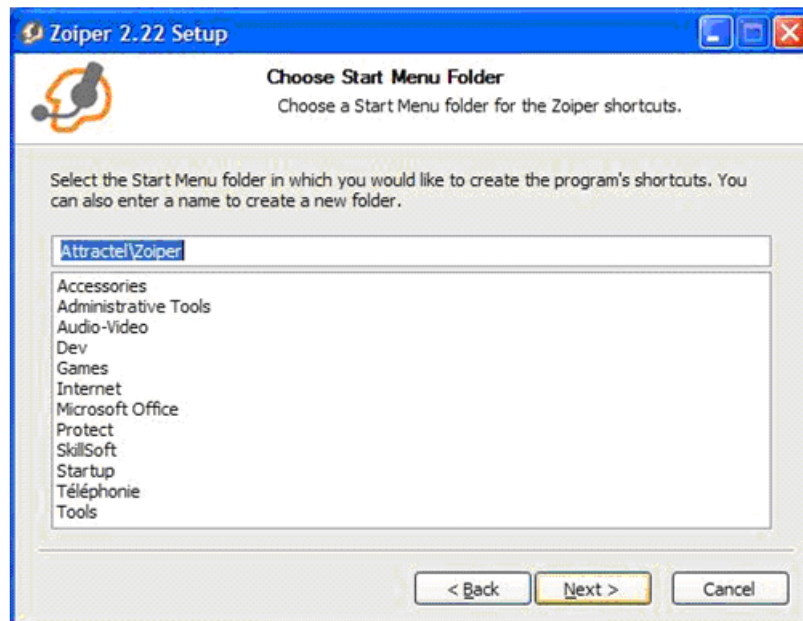
3) When the Licence Agreement screen shows up, click the **I Agree** button:



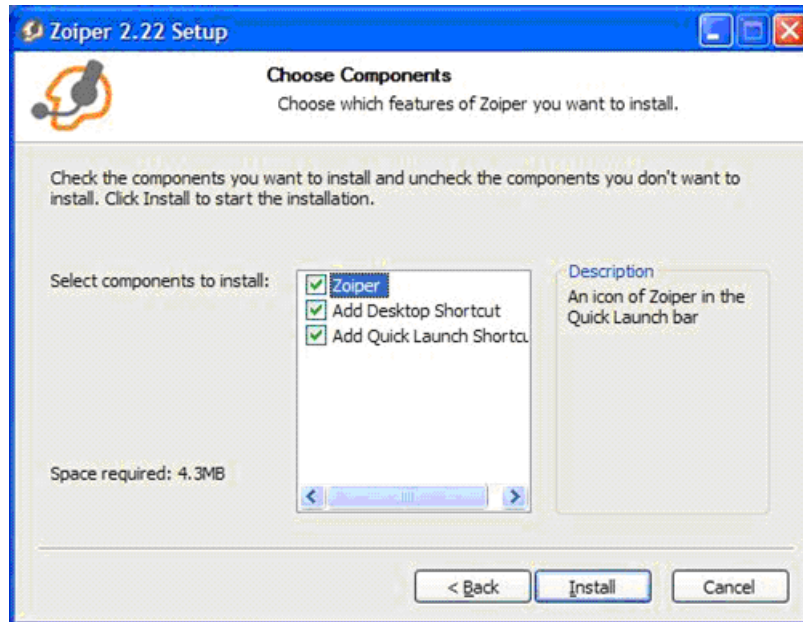
4) On the next screen, choose a directory where to install the application and click **Next**:



5) On the next screen choose a Start Menu Folder and click **Next**:



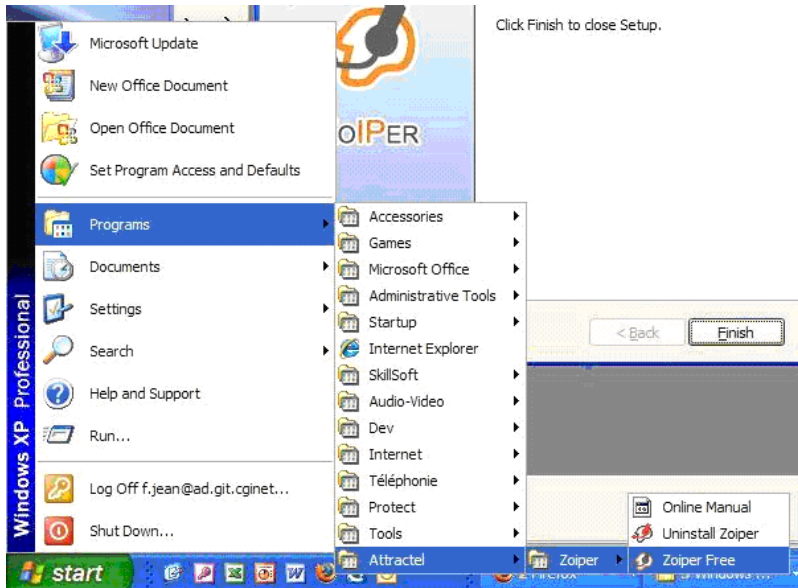
6) Select the components to install on this screen and click the **Install** button:



7) When the installation is done, just click on the **Finish** button to close the installation program:



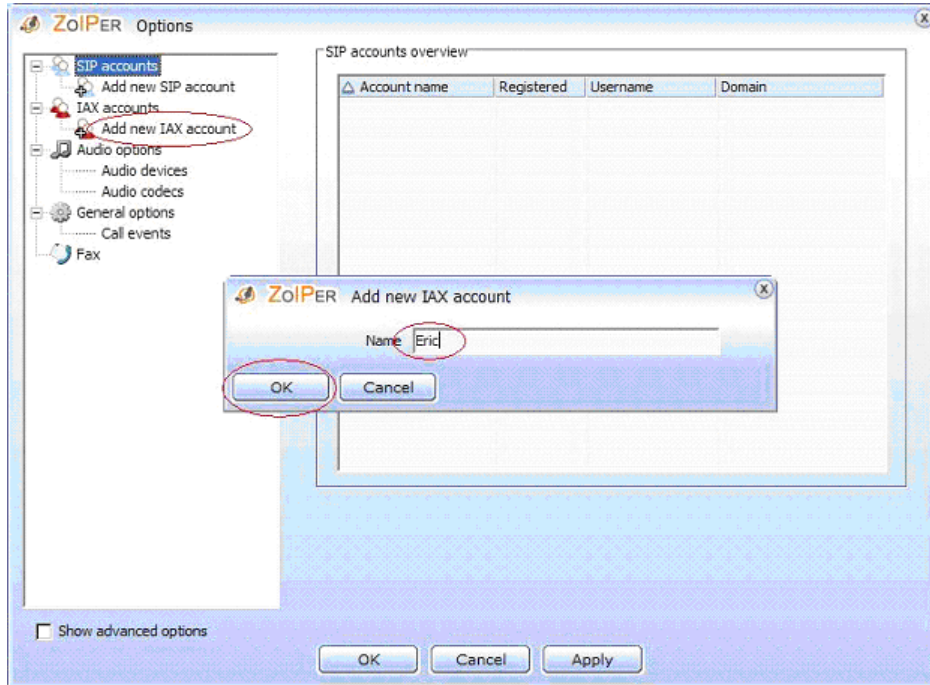
8) Start Zoiper by selecting it from the Start Menu:



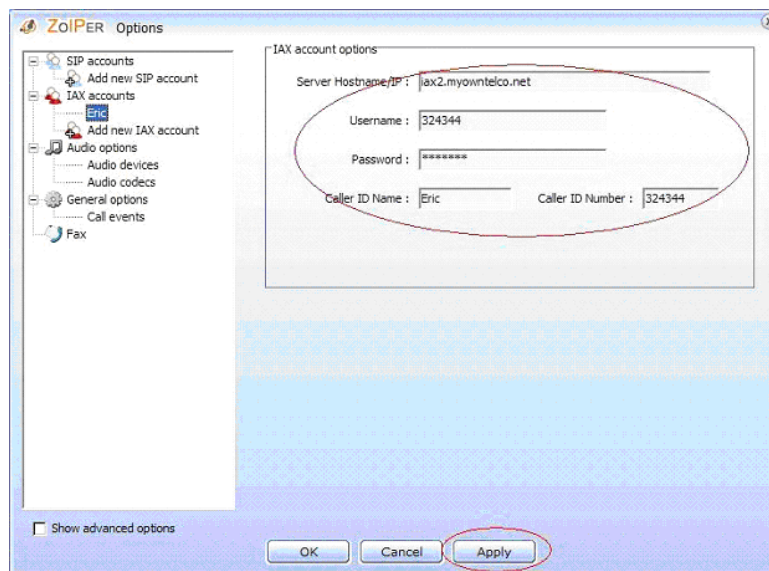
9) When the interface shows up, click on the **Options** button which is represented by a small blue wrench:



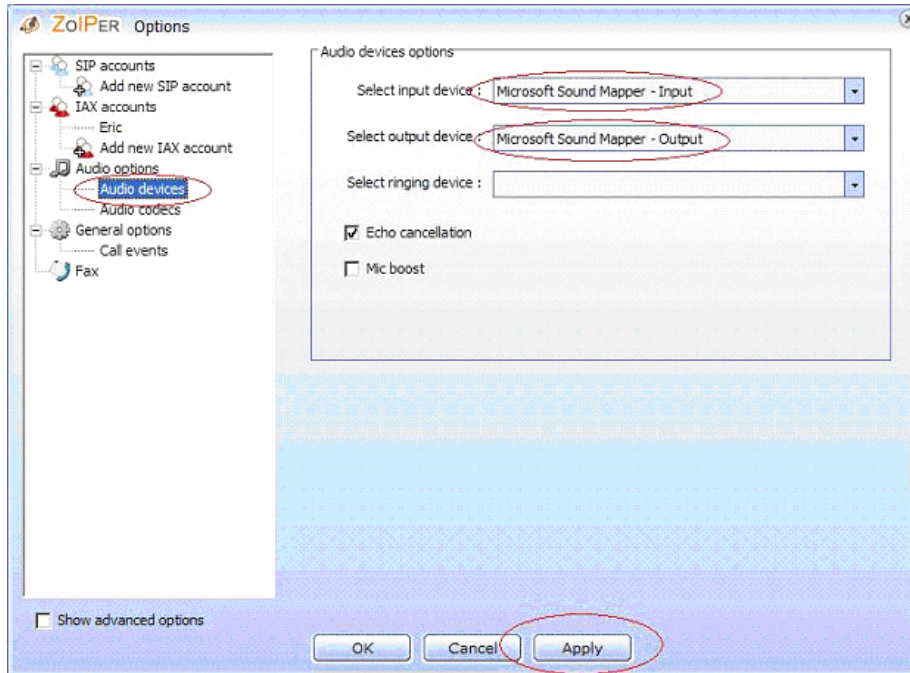
10) On the **Options** window, select **Add new IAX account** from the menu, and enter a name for your account and click the **OK** button to continue your account setup:



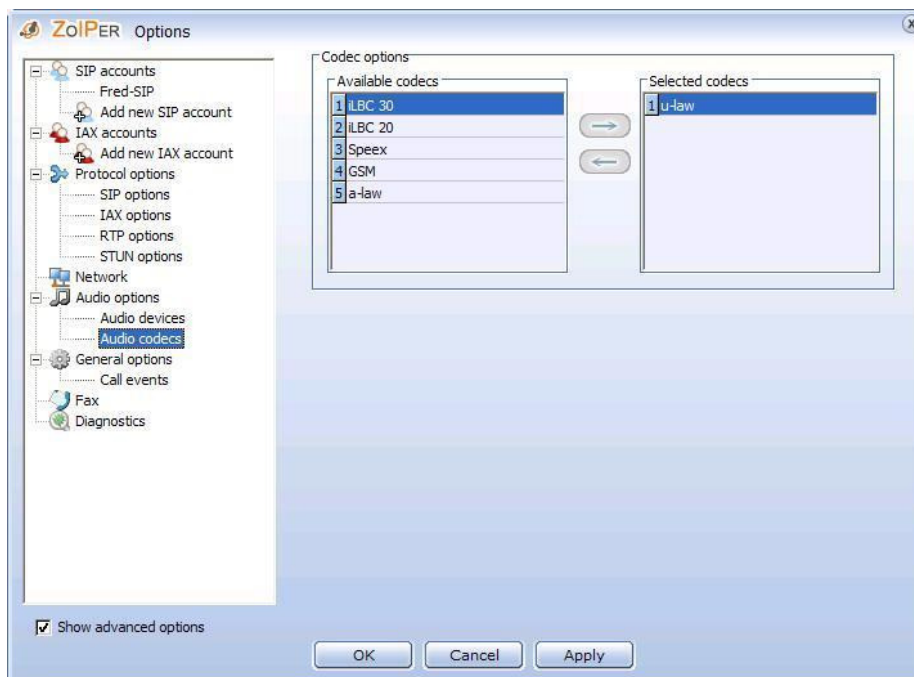
11) In the **IAX account options**, specify the **server hostname**, your account **username** (6 digits), your account **password** (6 digits) and your **caller ID number** and **name**. You will find this information in your account activation e-mail. If you don't already have a username and password, you can create one for free here: <http://myowntelco.net/your-account.php>. When done, click on the **Apply** button:



12) Select the **Audio devices** menu option and then select the correct devices for your microphone and speakers. When done, click on **Apply** and **OK** to close the window:



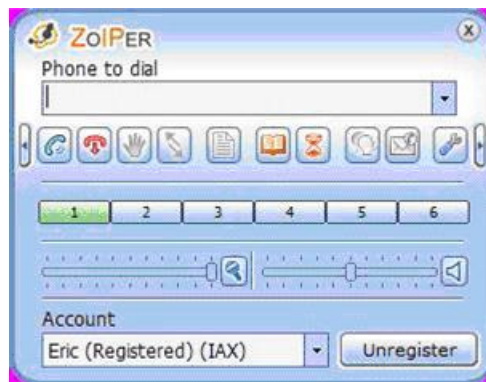
13) Select The **Audio Codecs** menu option and then only select the **u-Law** codec. When done, click on **Apply** and **OK** to close the window:



14) When back to the main window, click on the **Register** button if not already registered:

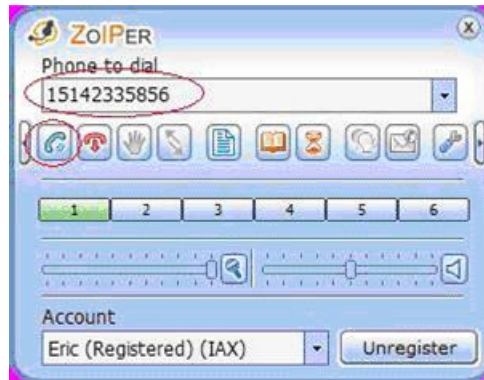


15) When Zoiper is registered, the text "Registered" will appear on the main interface:



If for some reason the interface does not show the word **Registered** a few seconds after you have clicked the **Register** button, please review your account information from the **IAX account options** windows and try again.

You can now type in a number to dial and click on the blue phone icon to send the call to the server:
